Theses should be 2 **full** pages of A4 format. The abstract should be up to 50 words.

Margin sizes: left – 3 cm, right – 1.7 cm, top and bottom – 1.5 cm. Font – Times New Roman, size

-12 pt. line spacing -1.0.

Order of placement of material:

- on the left edge, the UDC is presented in normal font, size 14 pt;
- in the next line, the name of the report is printed in CAPITAL letters in a semi-bold font, alignment by the center, size 14 pt;
- omitting a line, the names and surnames of the authors are printed in italics, the alignment is centered, the size is 12 pt;
- from a new line under the authors' surnames a place of work/study, city, country, alignment on the right edge, size 12 pt;
- after skipping a line, annotations and keywords in Ukrainian and English are printed with a 12-pin, alignment by width, paragraph indent 1 cm;
- after skipping one line, from paragraph 12, the main text is typed, alignment is by width, paragraph indentation is 1 cm;
- formulas, figures, and tables must have simple Arabic through-line numbering and must be placed after their mention in the text, alignment in the center;
- the list of references is printed in 10 points one line after the main text in accordance with the rules for the design of the bibliographic description. The title "**Literature**" is printed in the center with 12 points.
