REQUIREMENTS **ABSTRACT FOR FORMATTING**

The abstracts must be submitted in electronic form using the WORD text editor (version 6.0 or higher) for WINDOWS. Length – up to 5 pages, font size 12, Times New Roman, line spacing 1.5 (table headings and figure captions may be single-spaced), paragraph indentation – 1.5 cm, margins – 20 mm on all sides, without page numbering.

Structure of the material:

UDC (upper left corner, bold); next line – title of the paper (uppercase letters, bold, centered); next line – author's full name (bold italics, centered); next line – academic supervisor (full name, position, academic degree, academic title (if any); italics, centered); next line – author's place of study (italics, centered); next line – main text of the abstract; next line – list of references (the word REFERENCES in uppercase letters, bold, centered).

The list of references should be arranged in alphabetical order, in accordance with the current requirements of bibliographic description.

In the text of abstracts, references should be provided in square brackets: the number of the source corresponding to the number in the list of references; after a comma - the abbreviation "p." followed by the page number. Example: [1, p. 44].
