



REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts are to be submitted electronically.
The length should be up to 3 pages, font size 12 pt, Times New Roman, single line spacing, paragraph indent 1 cm. Margins: left – 2.5 cm, right – 1 cm, top and bottom – 2 cm. Pages should not be numbered.

Structure of the abstract:

- UDC (top left);
- next line – title of the paper (uppercase letters, bold, centered);
- next line – author(s) name and surname (italic, bold, centered);
- next line – name and surname of the scientific supervisor, academic degree, academic title, affiliation, city, country (bold, centered);
- after one line – abstract in Ukrainian (if the abstract is written in Polish, an abstract in the original language must also be provided) and keywords (up to 50 words, font size 10 pt);
- next line – title of the paper in English (uppercase letters, bold, centered);
- next line – author(s) name and surname in English (italic, bold, centered);
- next line – name and surname of the scientific supervisor, academic degree, academic title, affiliation, city, country in English (bold, centered);
- after one line – abstract in English and keywords (up to 50 words, font size 10 pt);
- after one line – main text of the paper;
- after one line – References in Ukrainian and English (bold, centered), arranged alphabetically in accordance with DSTU 8302:2015.

Citations should be indicated in square brackets, specifying the reference number in the list and the page number of the cited source.
